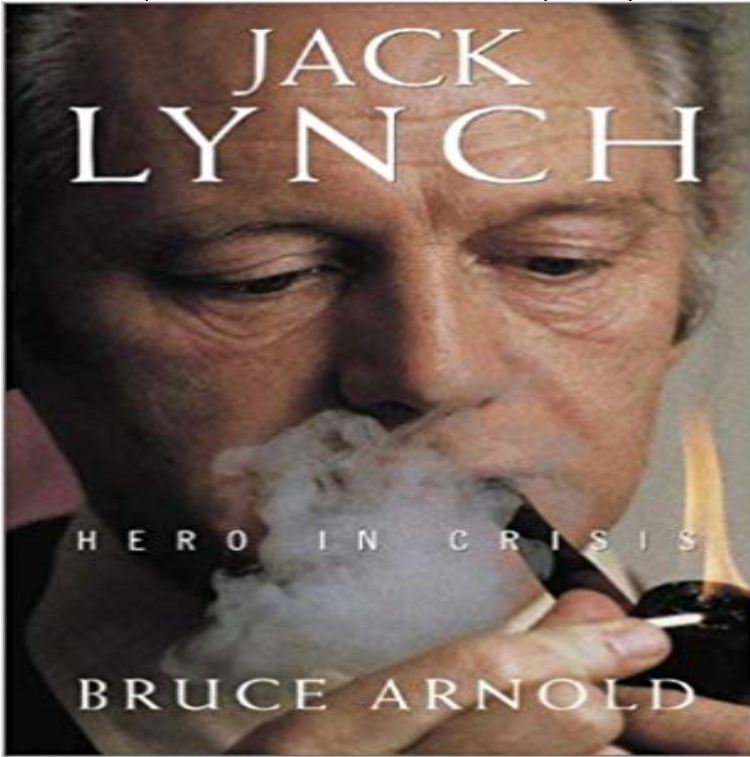


Jack Lynch: Hero in Crisis (v. 1)
