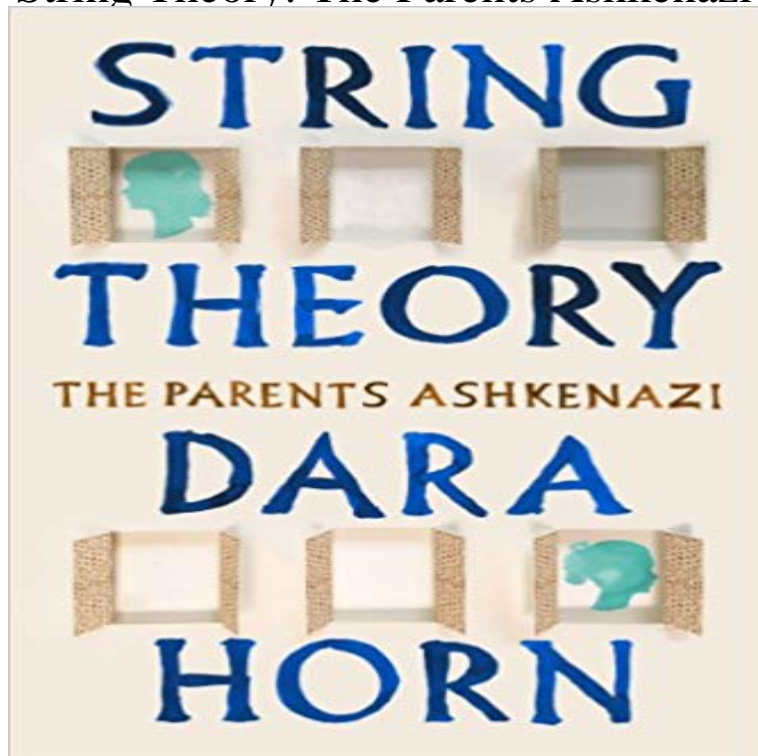


String Theory: The Parents Ashkenazi
