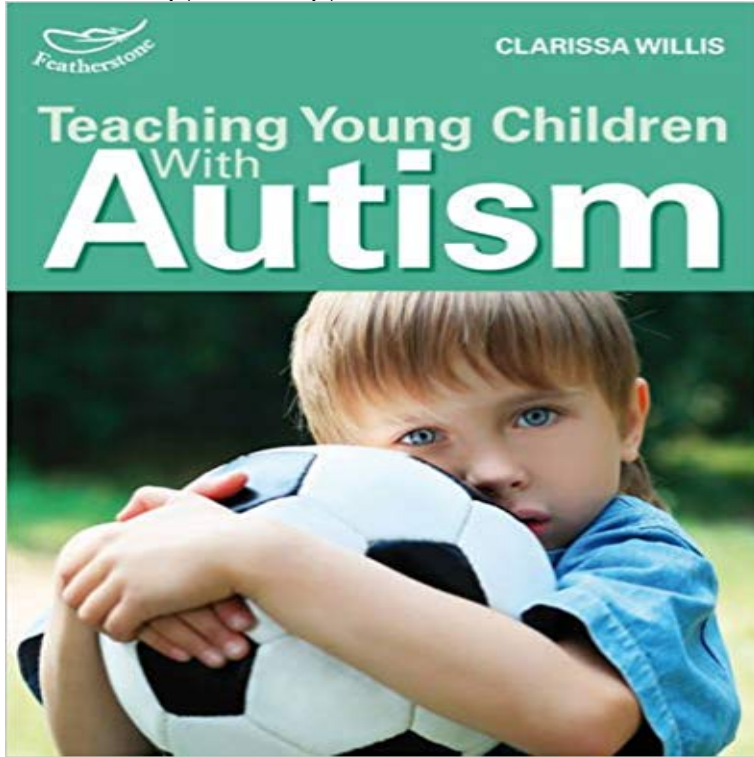


Teaching Young Children with Autism
