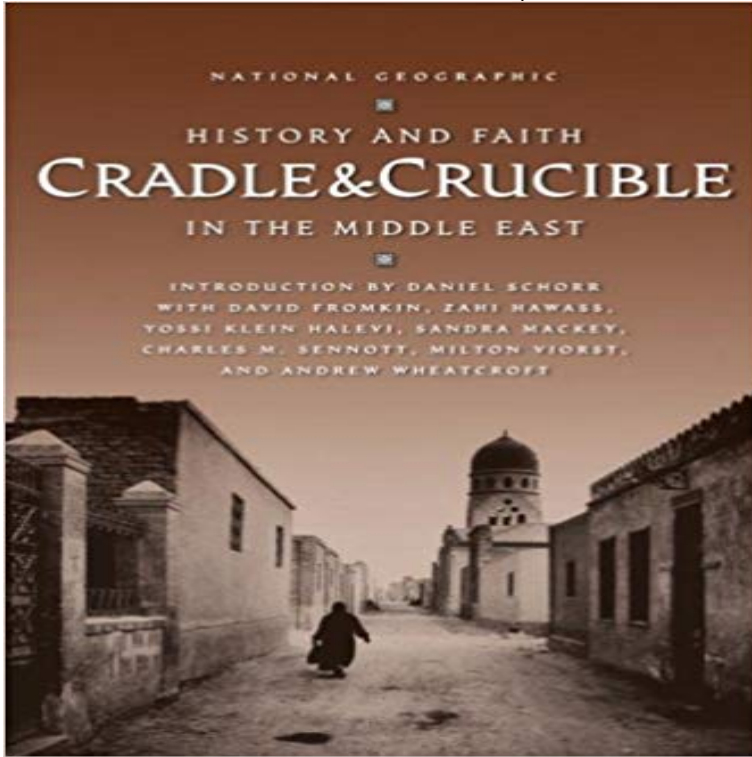


Cradle & Crucible: History and Faith in the Middle East
