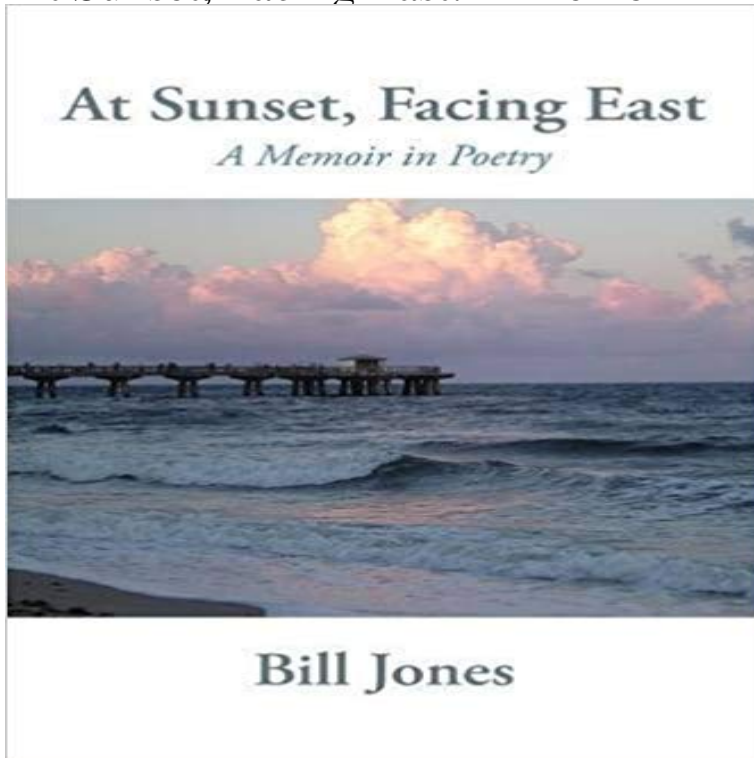


At Sunset, Facing East: A Memoir in Poetry
