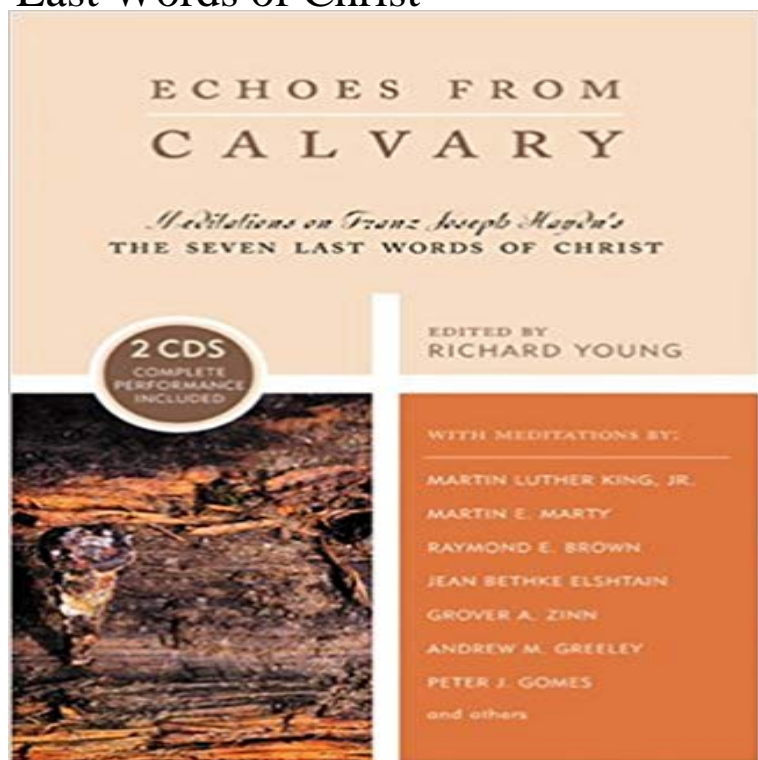


# Echoes from Calvary: Meditations on Franz Joseph Haydn's The Seven Last Words of Christ

Meditations include contributions by Martin Luther King, Jr., Martin Marty, Virgil Elizondo, Raymond Brown, Peter Gomes, Andrew Greeley, Jean Bethke Elshtain and many more. There are also in-depth essays by theologian Martin Marty, historian Grover A. Zinn, ethicist Jean Bethke Elshtain and the Vermeers Richard Young. On a second disk, Young demonstrates how Haydn's composition embodies the emotion of the seven last words. *Echoes from Calvary* offers many hours of spiritual reflection and devotion.
