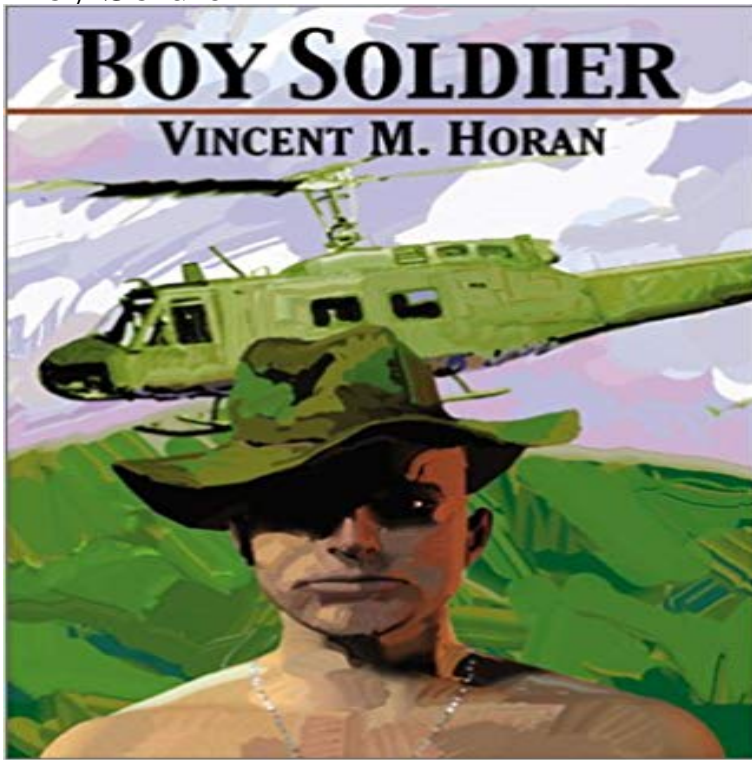


## Boy Soldier



The harsh realities of war remain mostly unseen to those who are left behind the families and friends of our service men and women who are sent overseas to face the awful truth of the horrifying and brutal actions of wartime. Through his powerful and touching words, we begin to get a glimpse of the private hell suffered by many of our veterans as Mr. Horan encourages other veterans to share their stories so that the healing may begin.
