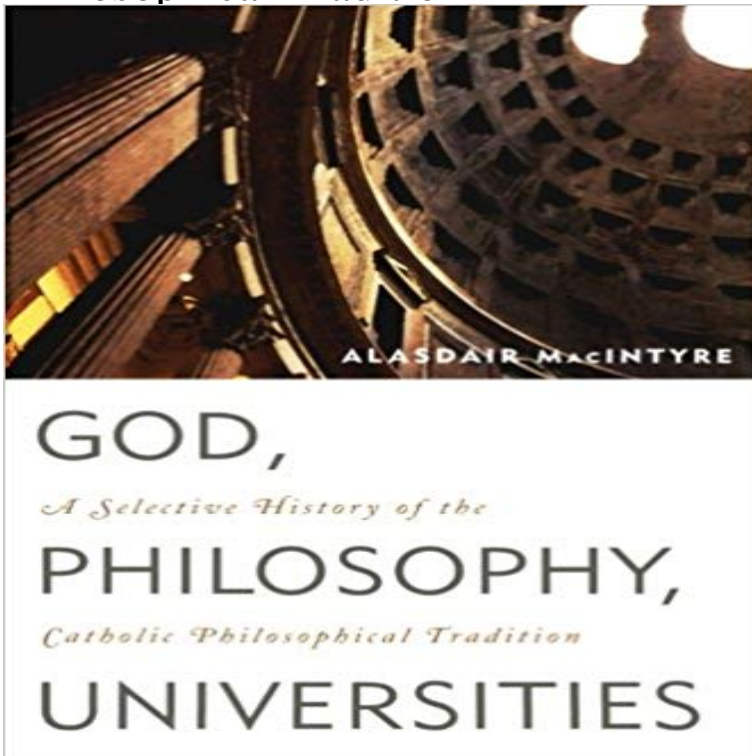


God, Philosophy, Universities: A Selective History of the Catholic Philosophical Tradition
