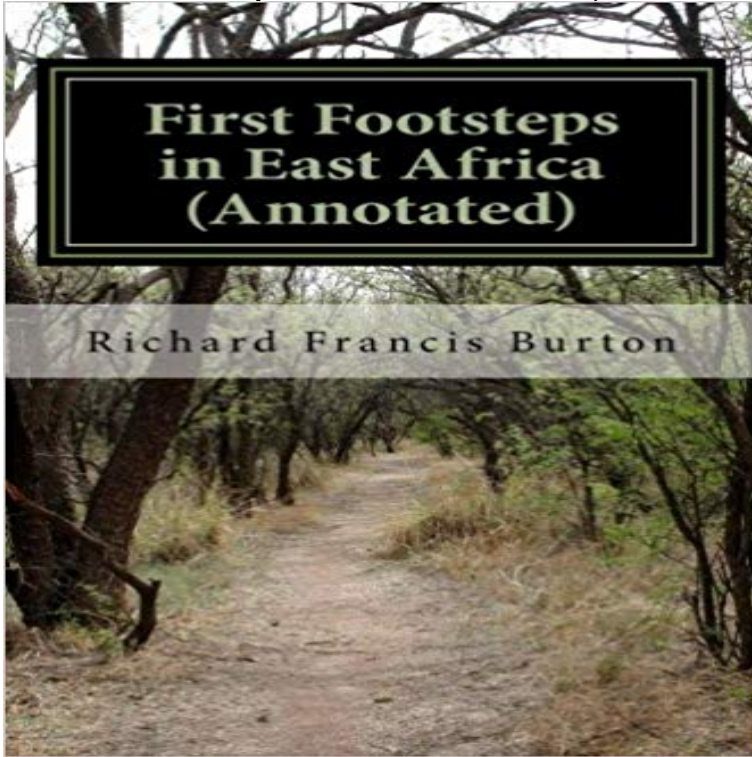


# First Footsteps in East Africa (Annotated): An Exploration of Harar
