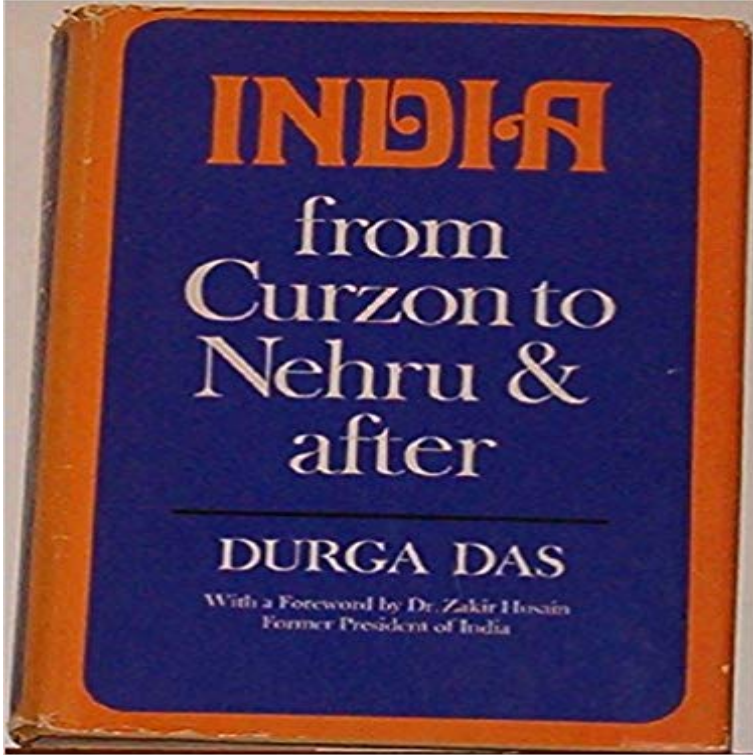


India (From Curzon to Nehru & after)
