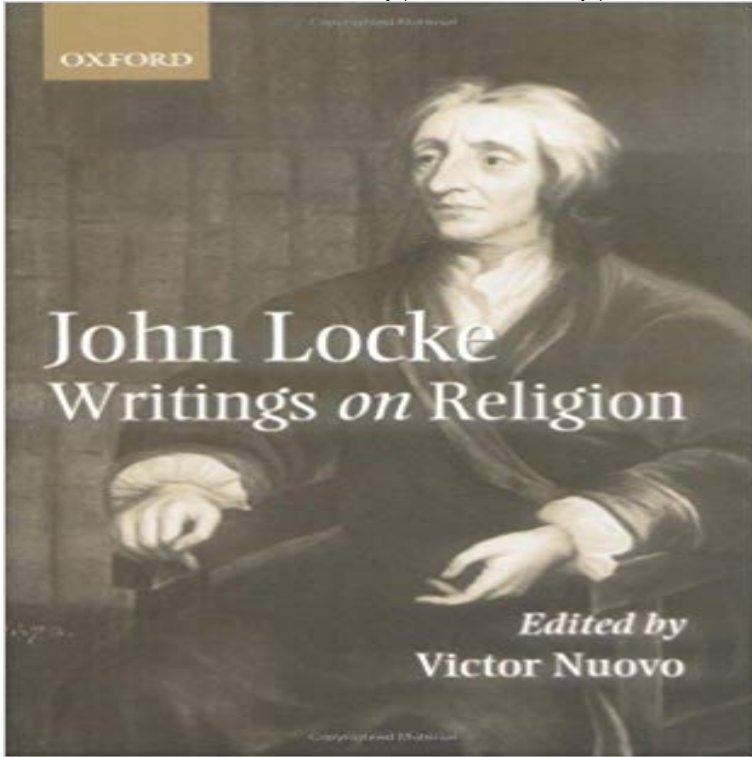


John Locke: Writings on Religion
