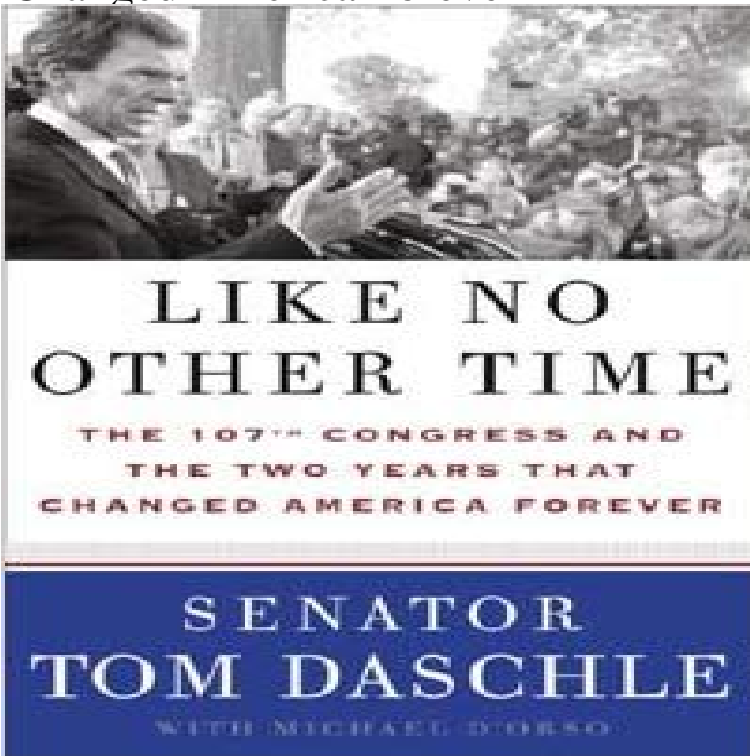


# Like No Other Time: The 107th Congress and the Two Years That Changed America Forever
