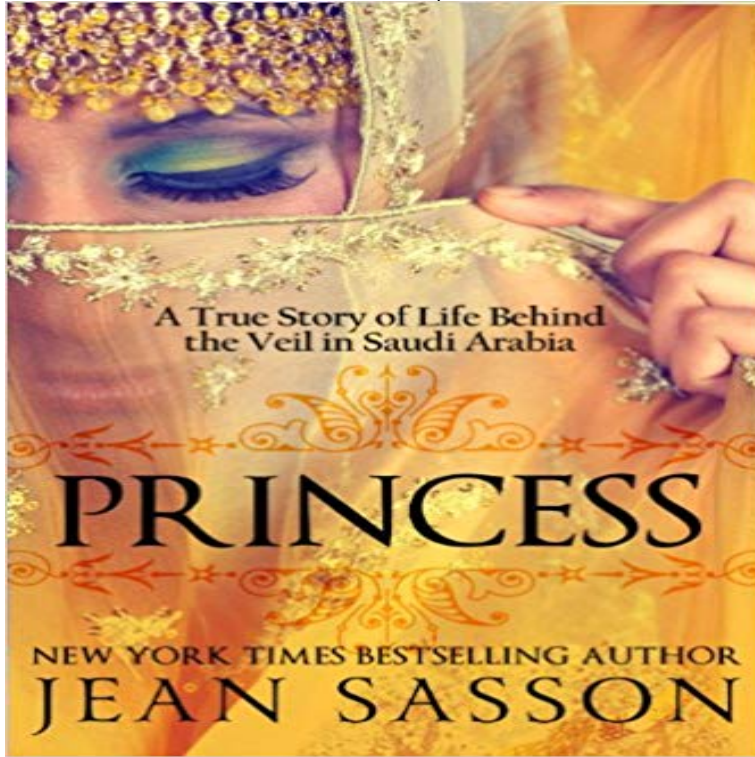


## Princess: A True Story of Life Behind the Veil in Saudi Arabia
