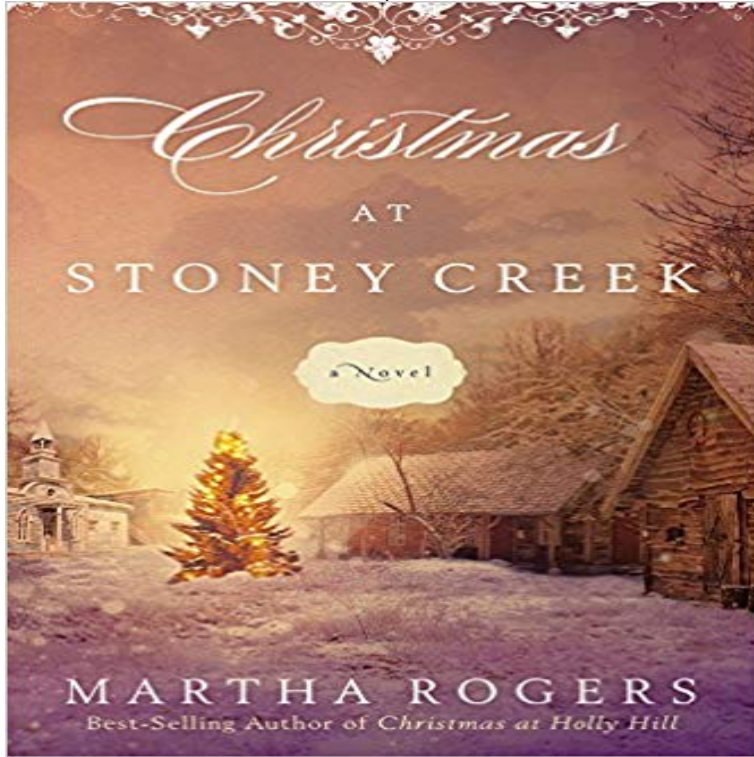


Christmas at Stoney Creek: A Novel
