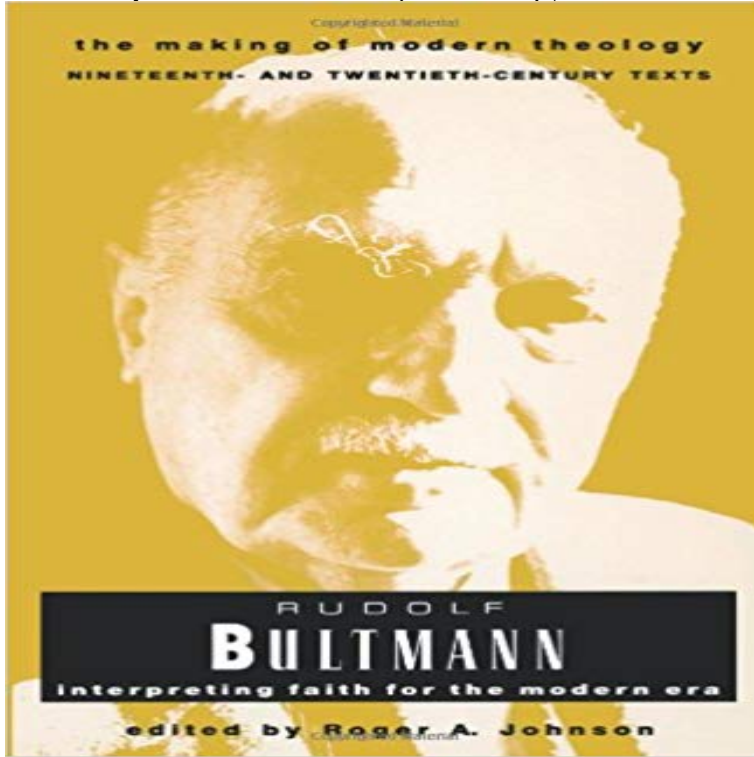


# Rudolph Bultmann (Making of Modern Theology)
