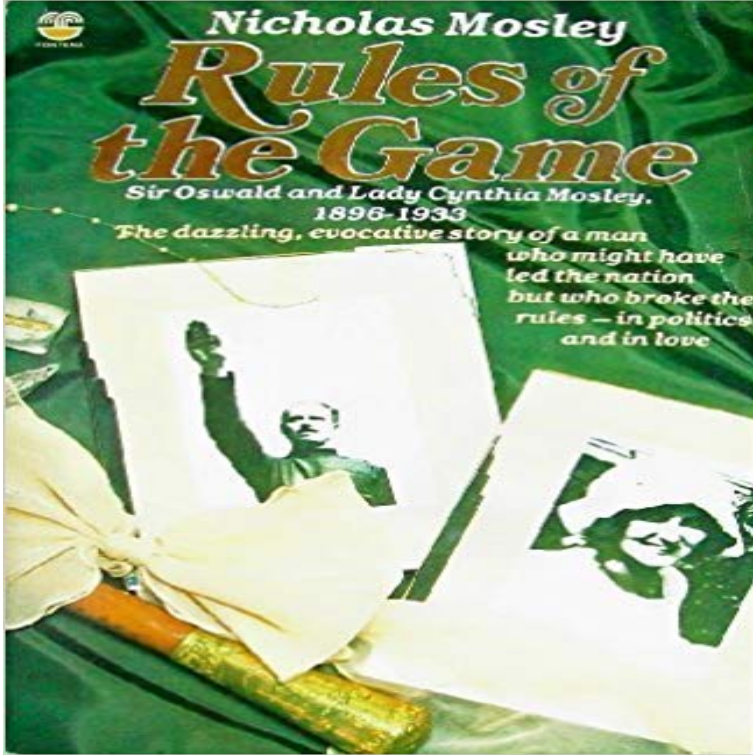


Rules of the Game: Sir Oswald and Lady Cynthia Mosley 1896-1933
