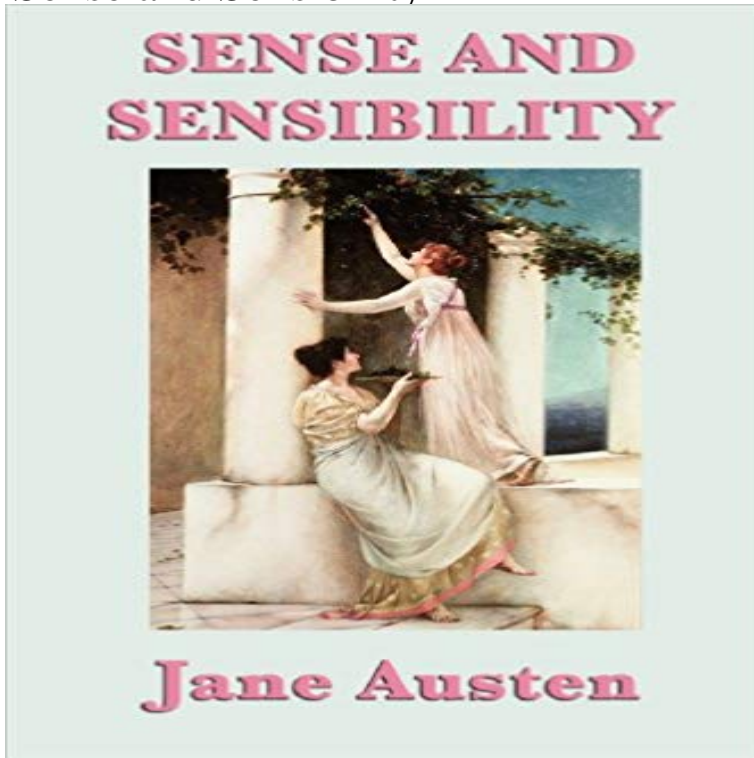


Sense and Sensibility
