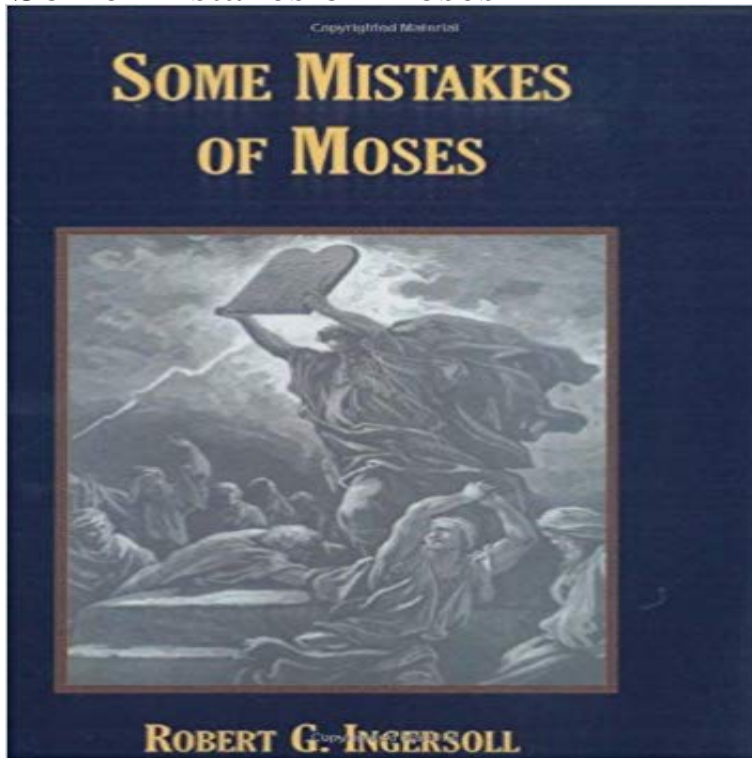


## Some Mistakes of Moses
