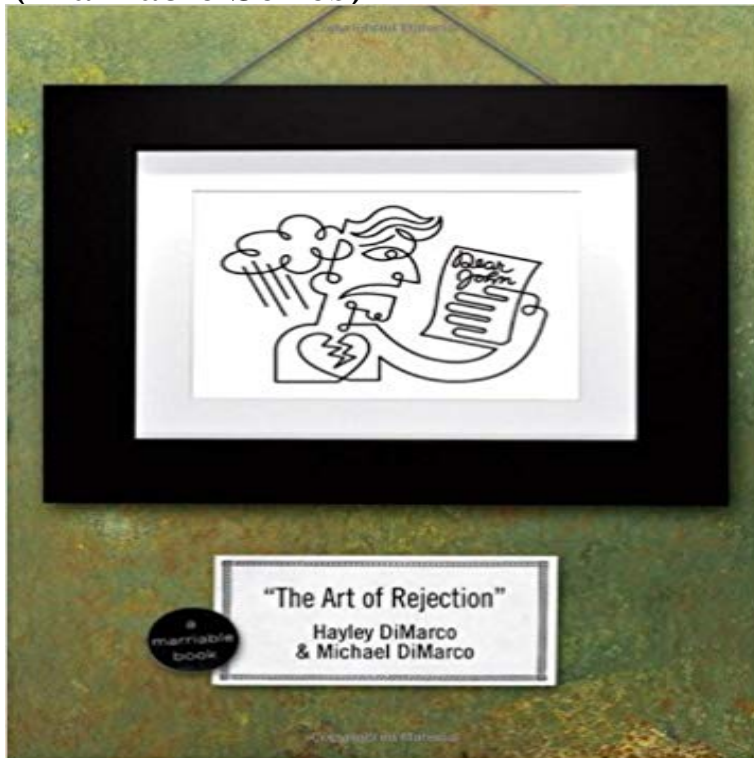


The Art of Rejection: Because Datings Not a Science---Its an Art (Marriable Series)
