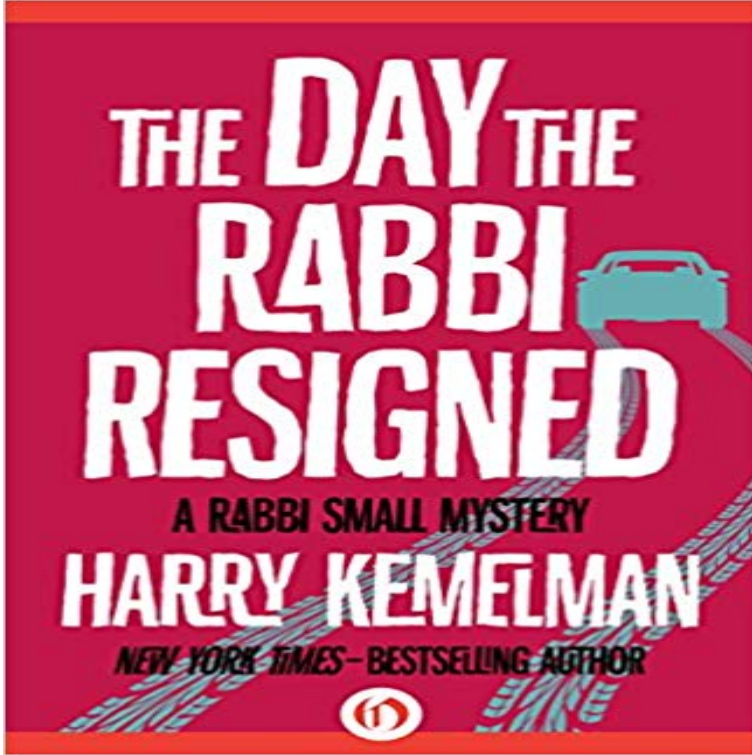


## The Day the Rabbi Resigned (The Rabbi Small Mysteries)
