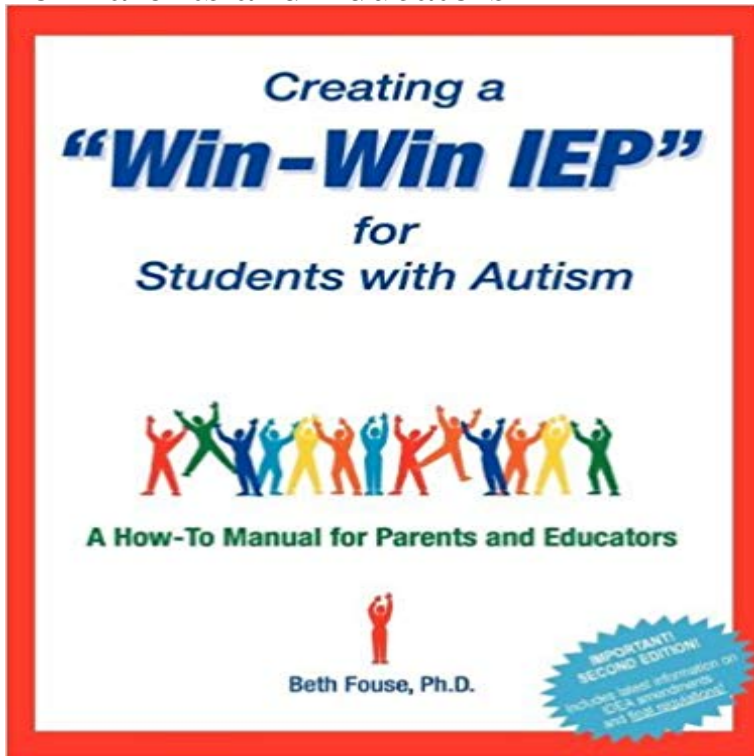


# Creating a Win-Win IEP for Students with Autism: A How-To Manual for Parents and Educators
