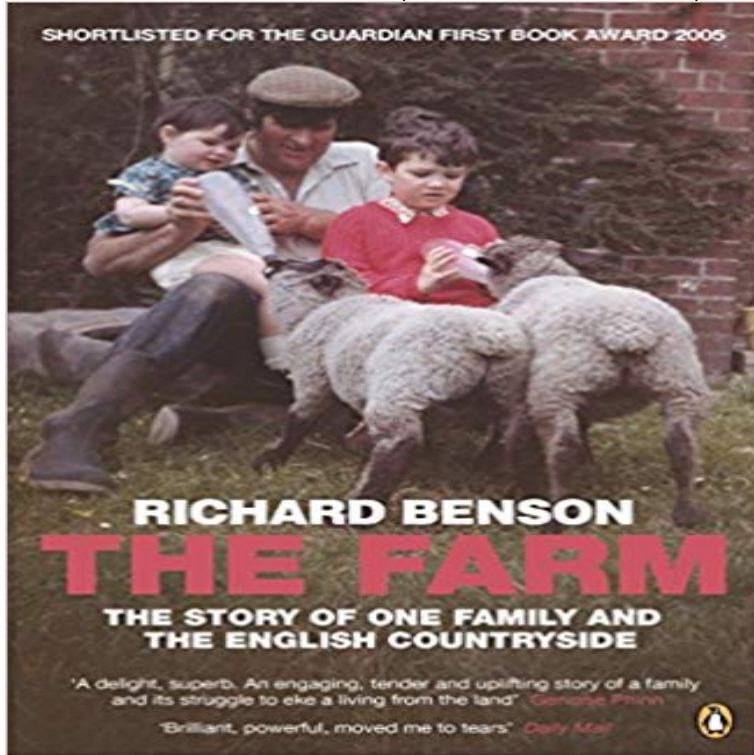


The Farm: The Story of One Family and the English Countryside
