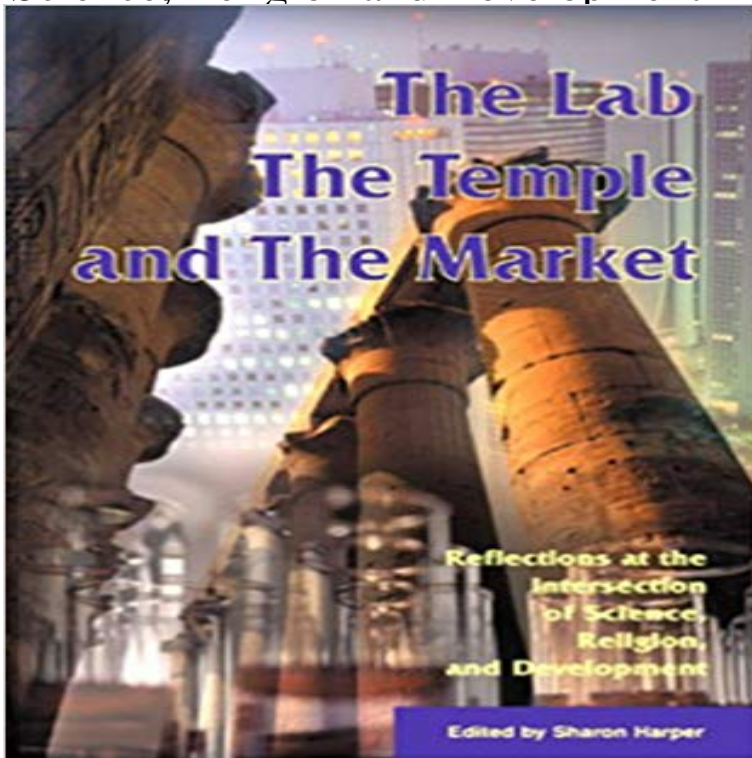


The Lab, the Temple, and the Market: Reflections at the Intersection of Science, Religion and Development
