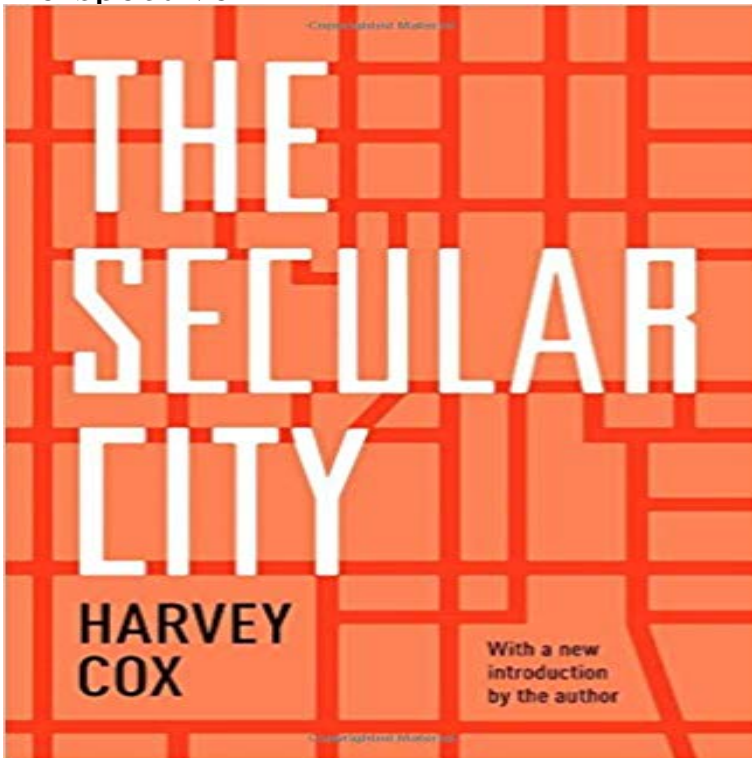


The Secular City: Secularization and Urbanization in Theological Perspective
