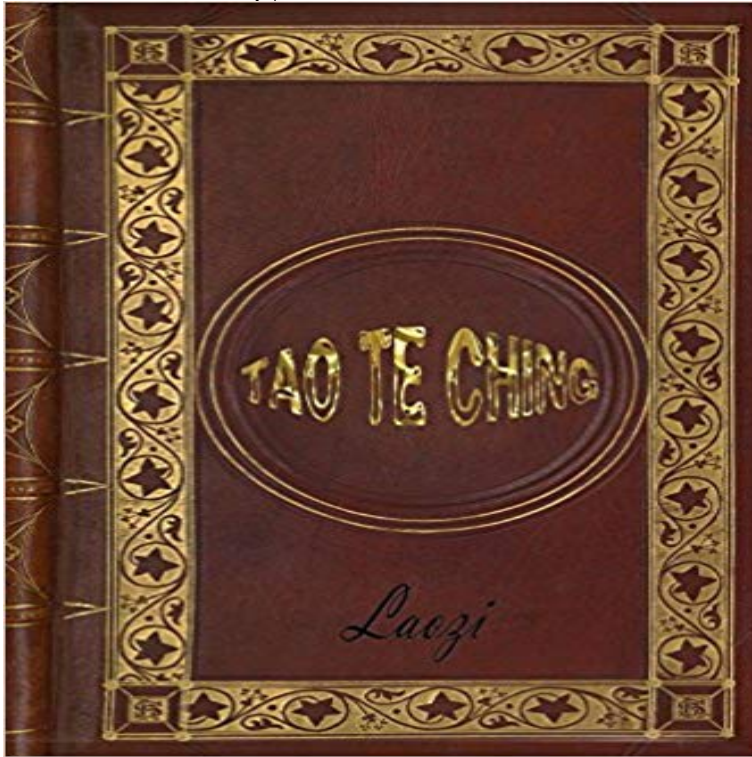


Tao Te Ching
