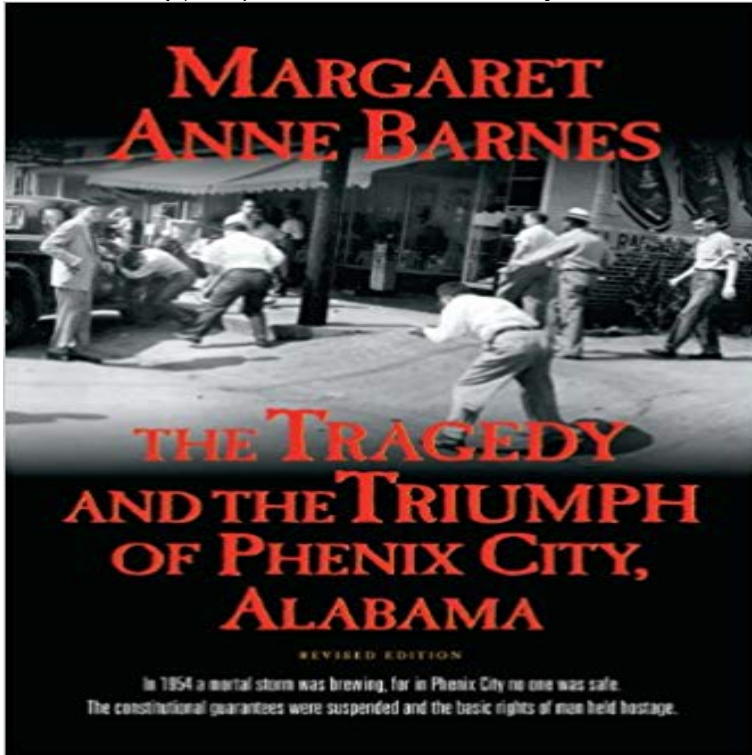


# The Tragedy and the Triumph of Phenix City, Alabama
