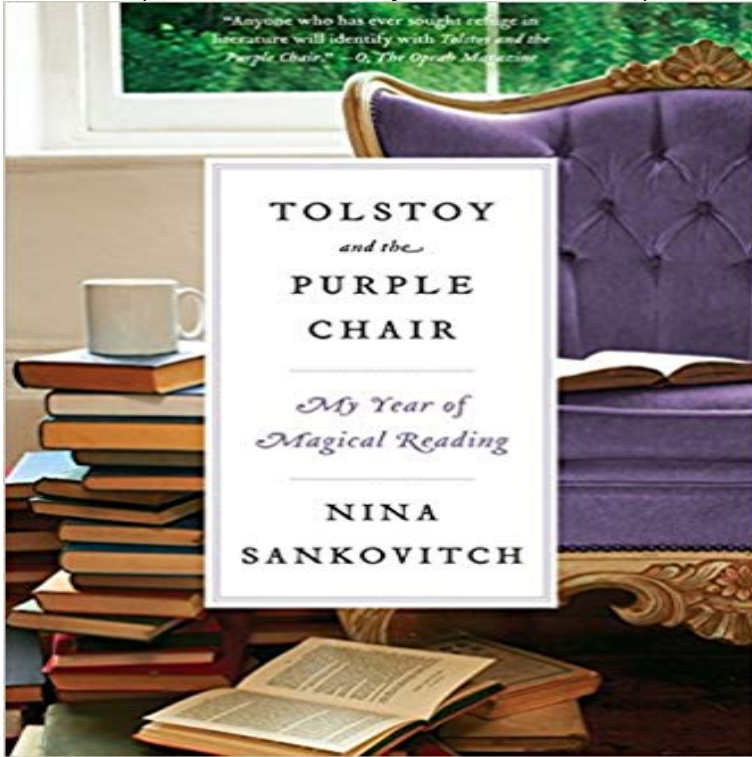


Tolstoy and the Purple Chair: My Year of Magical Reading
