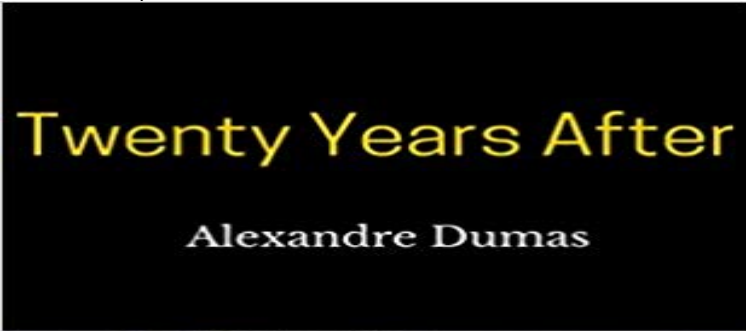


# Twenty Years After
