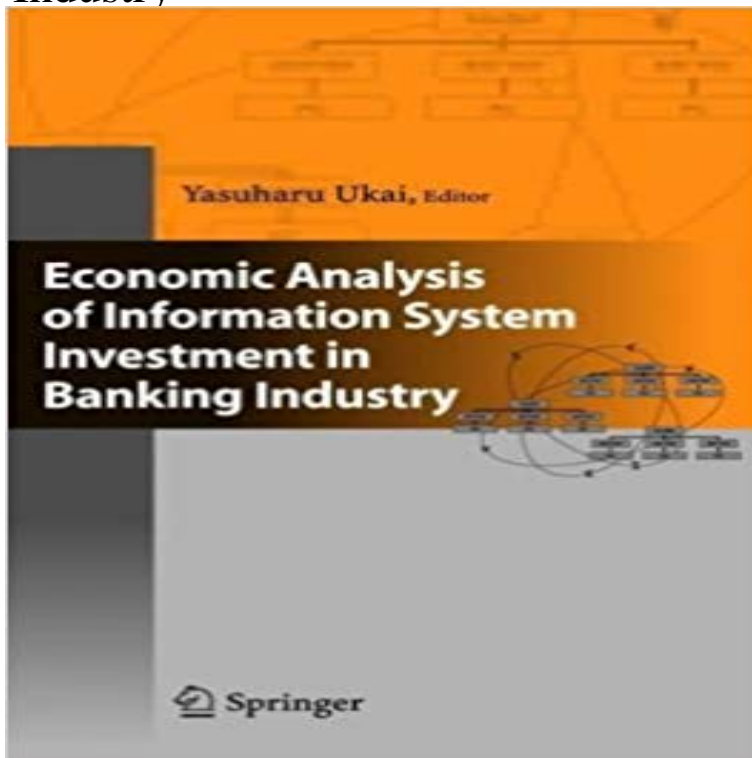


Economic Analysis of Information System Investment in Banking Industry
